

In-person Services @ Court Street

Attendance

- If you are **experiencing symptoms** associated with COVID-19, **please stay home**.
- If you do not feel comfortable attending because you are in a high risk group, a recording of the service will be available online Sunday afternoon.
- The recommended capacity for Phase 4 is 50 people.
- Please adhere to social distancing guidelines (6 feet apart).
- There is no need to sign in for attendance as there is no means to do so.

Entry

- **Please enter through the handicap door**; the main and education entrances will be locked.
- Important notices, such as liturgist, will be posted outside the sanctuary near the handicap vestibule and on the screens.
- However, please do not linger in the vestibule or socialize.
- To sign up for altar flowers or liturgist, call or email the church office.
- Ushers will guide you to a seat as the pews are taped off for social distancing (6 feet).

Service

- You must **wear a mask** during service.
- Families (households) may sit together.
- **There will be no nursery**, and children must stay with parents (guardians), even during the children's message.
- Bulletins will be available online if you would like to pull them up on a tablet or other device. If you bring a print-out of the bulletin, please take it with you when you leave.
- Otherwise, please refer to the screens.
- If you would like a paper bulletin, we may make them available under the condition that **you take them with you when you leave**.
- **Neither the full choir nor the congregation are to sing at this time.**
- Hymnals and Bibles have been removed from pews – you may bring your personal copy, but please take it with you when you leave.

Offering

- Offerings (apportionment or general) may be placed in the collection plate as you enter or as you exit.
- You may also mail offerings to the church office. Electronic giving through bank transfers is also an option (contact church office for details.).

Sanitation & Restroom

- The sanctuary will be cleaned after each service.
- Hand sanitizer will be dispensed by ushers. Ushers will wear gloves.
- Masks are available if you forget to bring yours.
- Please use the Narthex restrooms.
- The restrooms must be used one person at a time, except when accompanying your small child.

Exit

- **Wait for an usher to dismiss your row before you leave. Please exit through the handicap door.**
- Again, please do not linger in the vestibule or socialize.
- There **will be no Facetime** until further notice.
